From that moment on it became a special place in the heart of Amsterdam. Elegant scents of cherry, raspberry and red currant, but also violet and a light wsmokiness. The taste starts off solid with cherries and ends with a long, smooth finish.

Chateau Lafon-Rochet, Saint-Estephe, 2015
Classic Claret of left bank with high concentration and power. Almost a decade of bottle aging leads to the development of tobacco, cigar and pencil shavings,

while retaining its complexity of oak and dark fruits.

Syrah, Jean Luc Colombo, Cornas, 2018

A wide fragrance spectrum of blackberry, dark cherry, black pepper, cocoa, star anise licorice, leather, fennel and cedar wood. Firm, complex and elegant with dark fruits, ripe tannins, a hint of pepper, followed by a long, fresh finish.
